





ABOUT FLEETWOOD MAC



Fleetwood Mac was a British-American rock band originally formed in London in 1967. The band's initial lineup consisted of Peter Green, Jeremy Spencer, McVie. and John Fleetwood. Over the Fleetwood Mac had numerous changes in both members and musical direction, including Danny Kirwan and Bob Welch. It is their 1975 lineup of Lindsey Buckingham, Stevie Nicks, Christine McVie, John McVie,

and Mick Fleetwood that achieved the greatest commercial success.

Fleetwood Mac's breakthrough came with their self-titled album in 1975, which included hits like "Rhiannon" and "Landslide". The band's most iconic album, *Rumours* (1977), showcased a blend of rock, pop, and folk influences, featuring classic tracks such as "Go Your Own Way", "Dreams", and "The Chain". This album remains one of the best-selling records of all time and is widely considered the band's magnum opus. It is celebrated for its intricate harmonies and emotional depth that was fueled by infamous personal drama, including heavy substance use as well as breakups between various bandmates.

Fleetwood Mac's sound evolved over the years from their blues-rock roots to include elements of pop and FM rock, reflecting the band's versatility and the diverse influences of its members. Despite various lineup shifts and periods of hiatus, the band remains a mainstay of the modern-day music scene, with *Rumours* going 21x platinum in July 2023, over 46 years after its initial release. Following Christine McVie's death in 2022, Fleetwood Mac officially disbanded, with Stevie Nicks commenting in a 2023 interview that she saw no reason in the continuing the band without McVie.






